

# Accessibility statement for Iviamerica.com

LVI Low Vision International strives to ensure that our website can be handled, understood and accessed by as many people as possible. The website must therefore comply to the greatest extent possible with the guidelines in the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines, WCAG.

Below we describe how our website complies with WCAG and indicate known accessibility issues and how you can report any deficiencies to us so that we can address them.

## Technical information about the website's accessibility

This website largely complies with the guidelines in WCAG 2.1, level AA. However, there are certain parts that are not fully accessible in one way or another. This applies to the content described below:

- Some images lack clear alternative text descriptions, which can make it difficult for users with visual impairments to understand the content.
- The videos on the website do not include audio descriptions or transcripts, which means that users with visual impairments may have difficulty fully experiencing the content.
- Some older videos on the website consist only of visual content and do not offer alternative ways to access the information, such as a transcript. Most videos do not have embedded subtitles.
- For videos published after June 28, 2025, an English voice-over is used because the same videos are distributed across different geographic markets. We recommend that visitors use YouTube's automatically generated captions, where it is also possible to select the preferred language without fixed subtitles appearing in the background and causing distractions.
- Documents on the website are not accessible.

Our ambition is to address the above problems and we are continuously working to improve and maintain the accessibility of our website.
