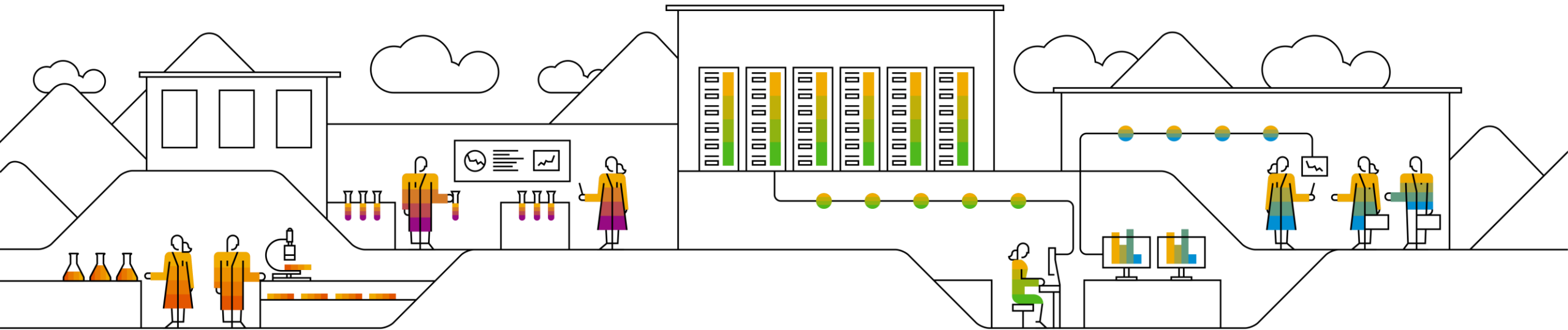

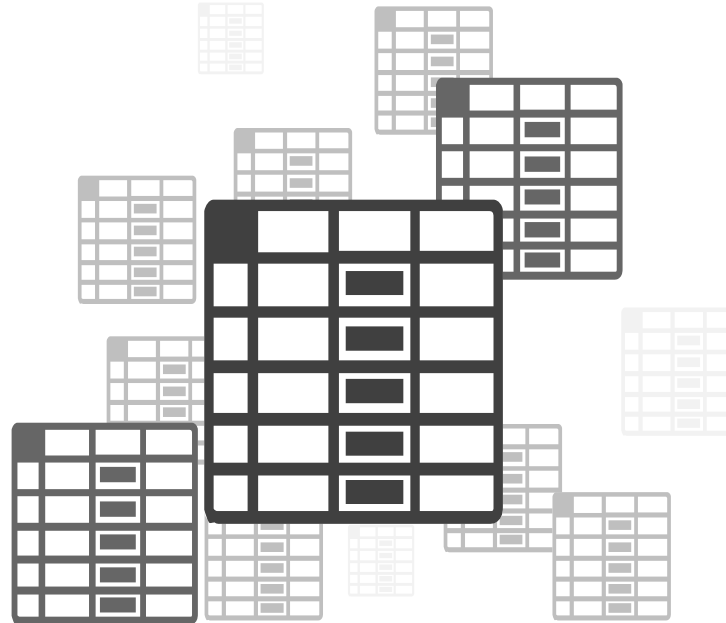

Most organizations still use spreadsheets

Desktop spreadsheets are the tools most commonly used.

7 out of 10 midsize or larger companies use them across the range of 11 planning processes we examined, yet nearly half (48%) of participants said that **spreadsheets make it difficult to manage planning processes.**



The research also confirms that spreadsheets are error-prone. More than one-third (35%) of organizations **routinely find errors in data, and one-fourth (26%) find errors in formulas.** Finding and fixing errors is another reason why spreadsheets are time-consuming.

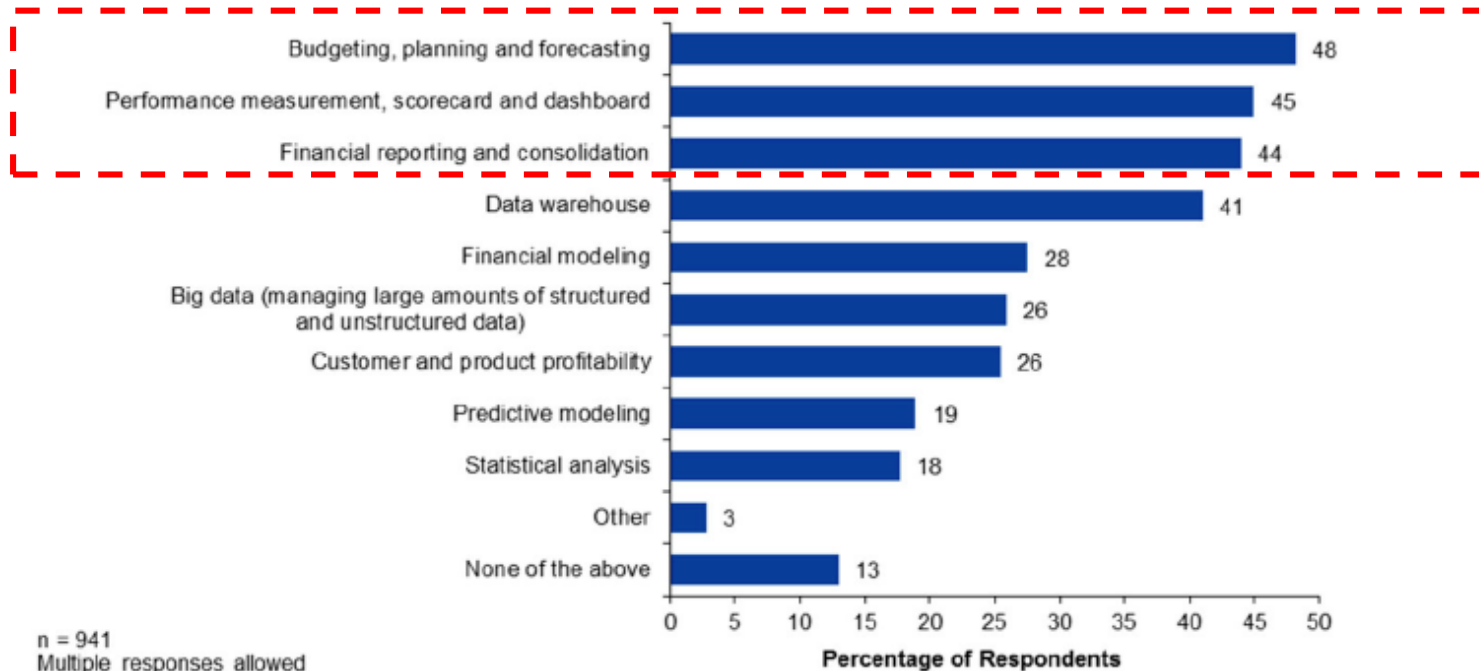

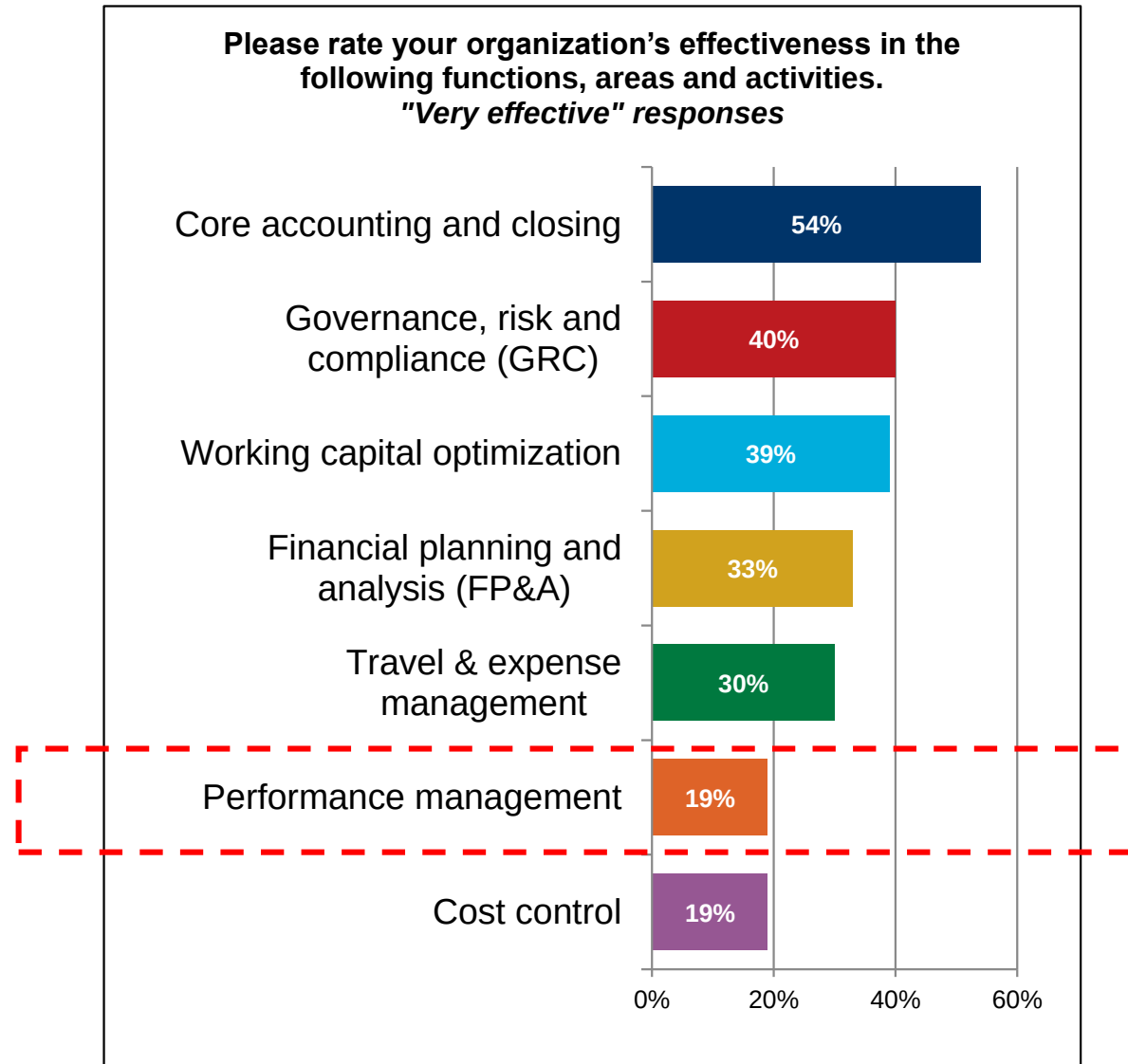
Figure 4. Business Analytics Upgrades Which of the following business analytics technologies is your organization currently upgrading or enhancing?

Planning: Definition

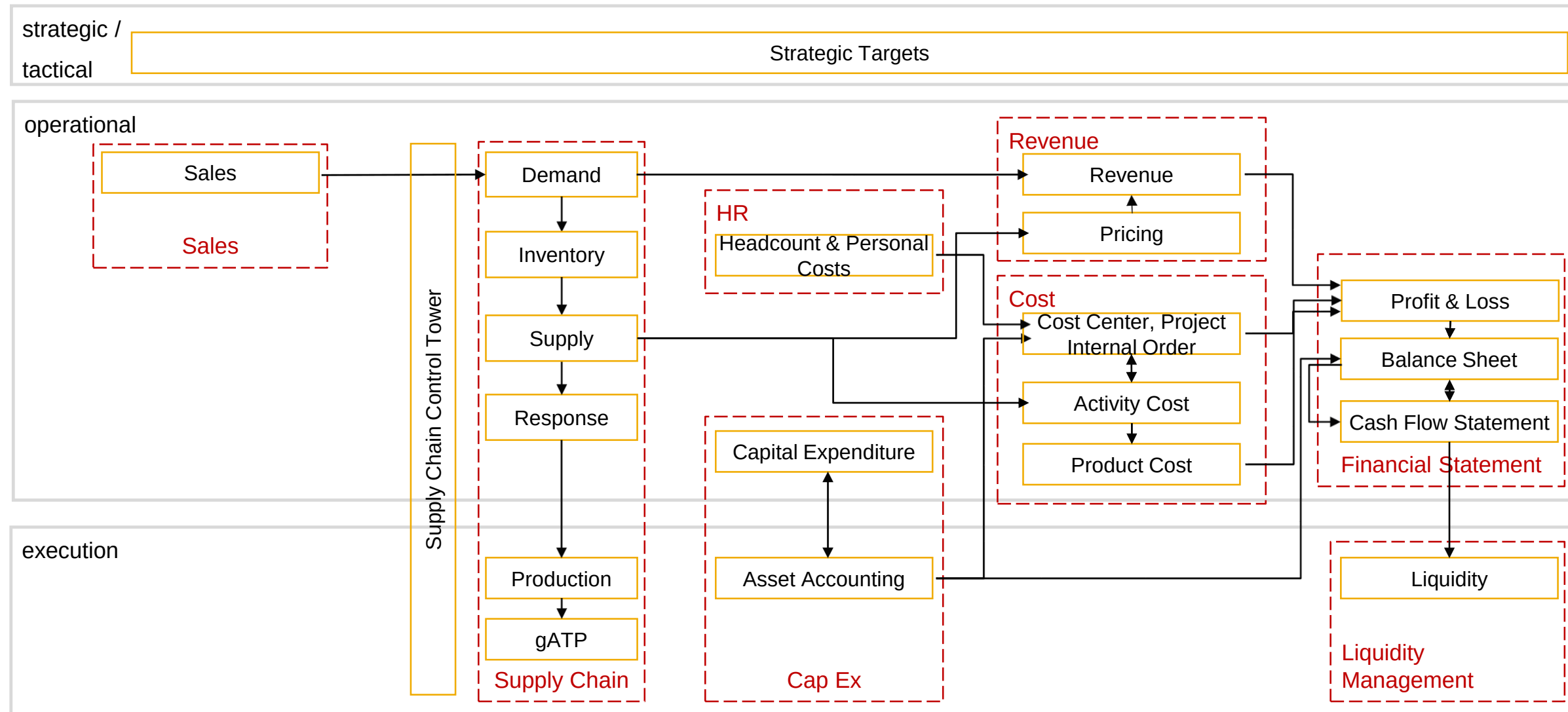
